- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late
- Members must wear suitable kit —clean non marking squash shoes that haven't been worn outside at any time, clean comfortable sports clothing that allows you to run on court for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach.
- Eye protection is mandatory for Buckingham Squash & Racketball sanctioned events.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
